

<p><b>Re-create the solar system</b></p> <p>Research the solar system and re-create it. E.g. huge water slide, basketball court, dance studio.</p>	<p>I think of a number, add 3.7 and multiply by 5.</p> <p>The answer is 22.5</p> <p>What was my number?</p>	<p><b>PE spin board</b></p> <p>Create your own PE spin board and complete the exercise that you land on for 30 seconds.</p> 	<p><b>What if another advanced species existed?</b></p>
