



















## Year 2 Home Learning Grid – Week 8

When you have finished, add some colour to your drawings. What materials could you use to add colour?</p> <p>2.</p> 	<p><b>Crayon measuring</b></p>  <p>Who has the shortest crayon? Who has the longest crayon? How long is Ron's crayon?</p>	<p><b>Exercise dice</b></p> <p>Come up with an exercise that could be done with each number on a dice e.g. '5 star jumps'.</p> <p>Roll a dice and complete the exercises with a family member!</p> 	<p><b>What would you do in each scenario? Discuss this with a grown up.</b></p> <p>You receive a message from someone you don't know. What should you do?</p> <p>You are playing a game when a page pops up saying you have won a prize and asks you to click on it. What should you do?</p> <p>You see something online that upsets you. What should you do?</p> 
<p><b>Animal tracks</b></p> <p>Research some different jungle animals and the tracks they make. <p><b>Sick sentences</b></p> <p>Look at the jungle picture.</p>  <p>Read the 'sick sentences' below.</p> <p>Make them better by adding conjunctions, expanded noun phrases, adverbials and prepositions.</p> <p>There is a house. It is in the jungle. There are plants. There are flowers.</p>	<p><b>How much is that fruit?</b></p> <p>An apple and banana cost the same as a pineapple.</p> <p>Two pears cost 40p.</p> <p>Bananas cost the same as pears.</p> <p>An apple costs 3p less than a pear.</p> <p>What is the cost of a pineapple?</p>	<p><b>Grow your own rainbow</b></p> <p>Follow the instructions to 'grow your own rainbow' on the separate sheet.</p> <p>Send pictures of your rainbows!</p> <p>You could display them in your windows to make people smile.</p> 	<p><b>Would you rather grow up quickly or stay a child forever?
