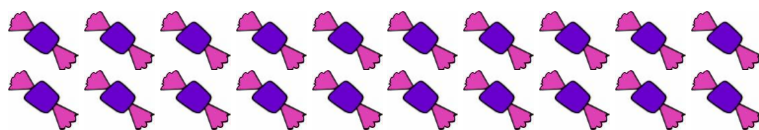


Task 1 – Look at the 'Division as Sharing' sheet to help you solve the division calculations.

1. Divide these Sweets into 5 equal groups:



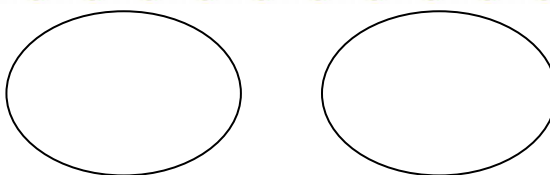
$$20 \div 5 =$$



2. Divide these bananas into 2 equal groups:



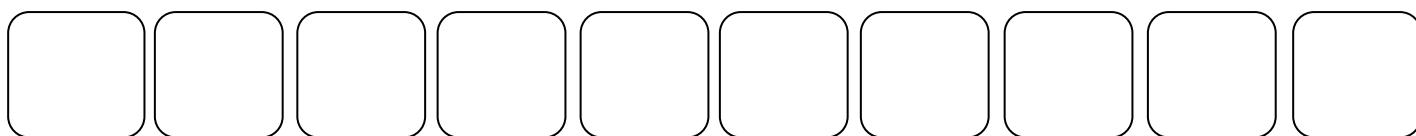
$$12 \div 2 =$$



3. Divide these cakes into 10 equal groups:



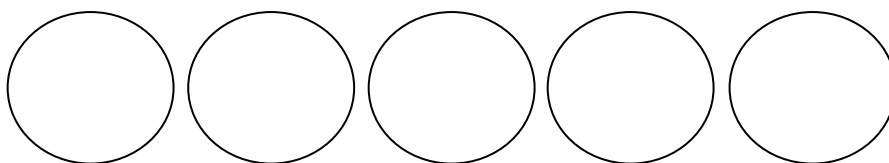
$$20 \div 10 =$$



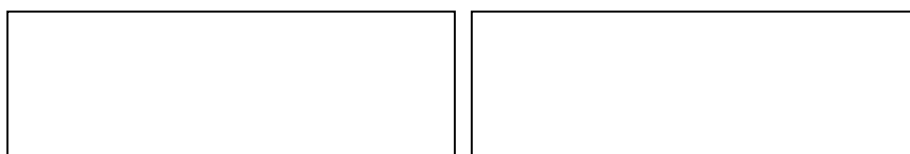
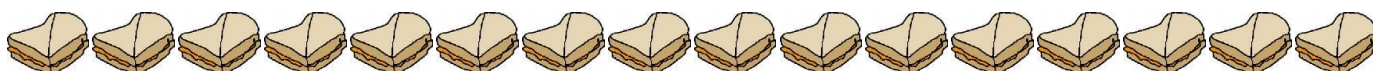
4. Divide these cherries into 5 equal groups:

How many groups can you make?

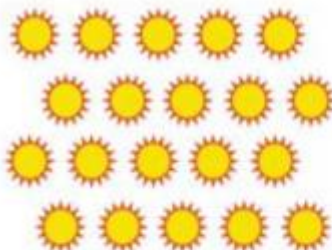


$$16 \div \underline{\quad} = 8$$

How many groups can you make?

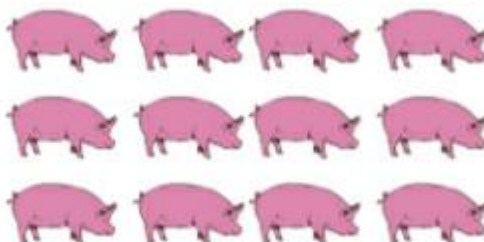


$$\underline{\quad} \div 5 = 3$$

Put the pigs into **groups of 2**.

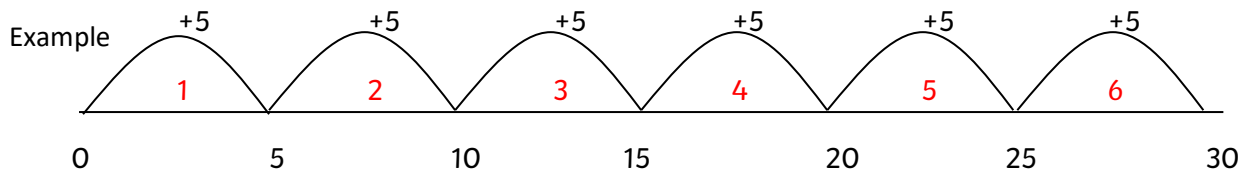
How many groups are there?
