






Task 1- Complete this task if you work with Mrs Clare or Mrs Southworth for phonics.

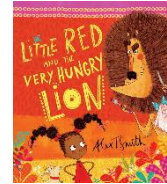
Task 2- Complete this task if you work with Miss Francis or Miss Marsden for phonics.
