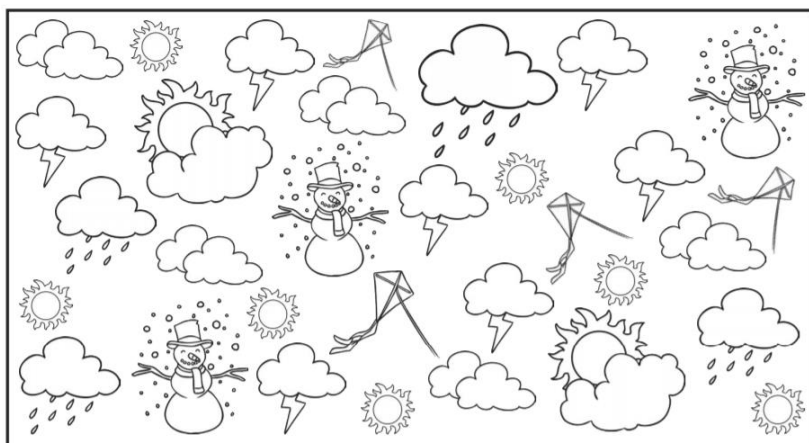
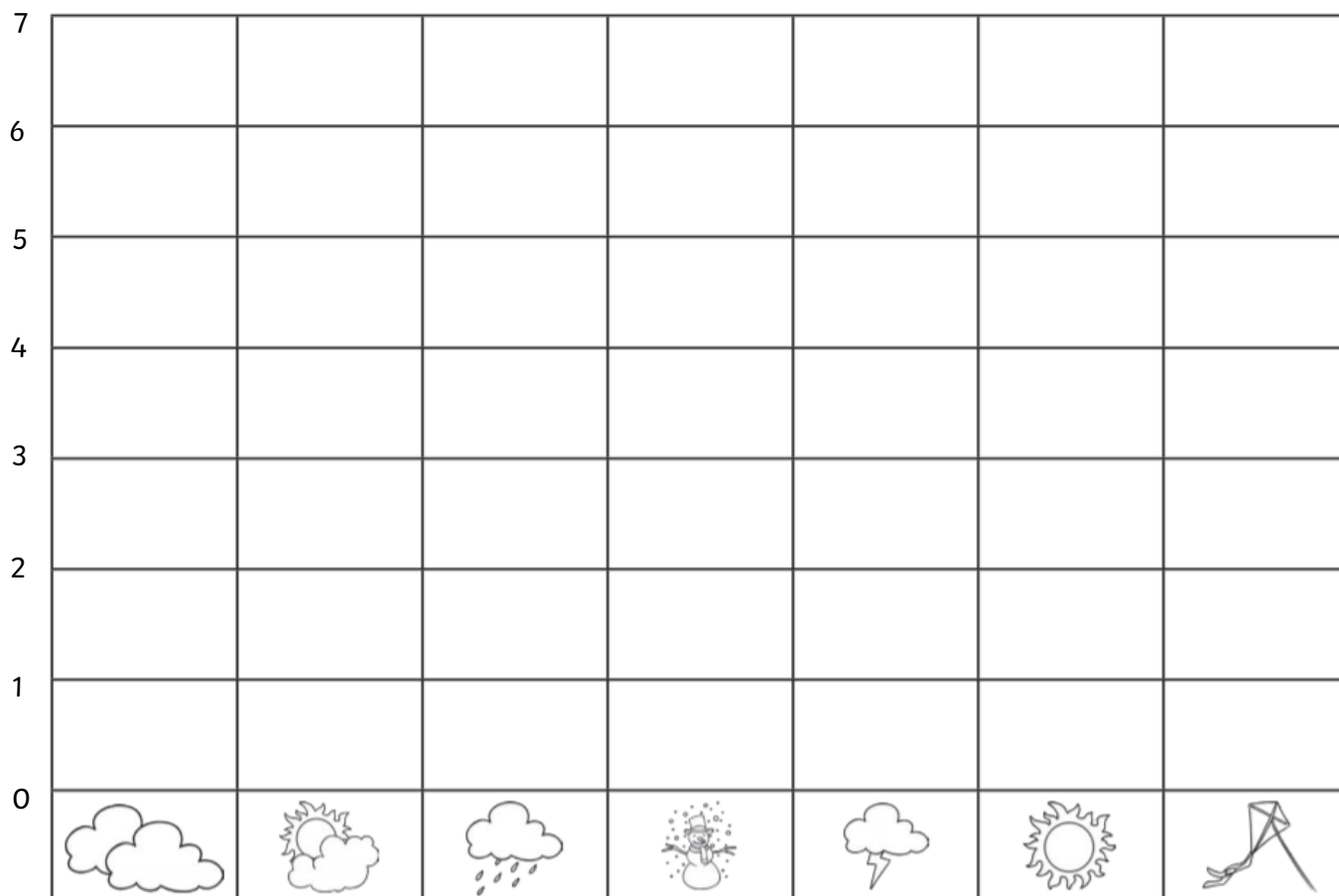

Colour a box for each item that you find.



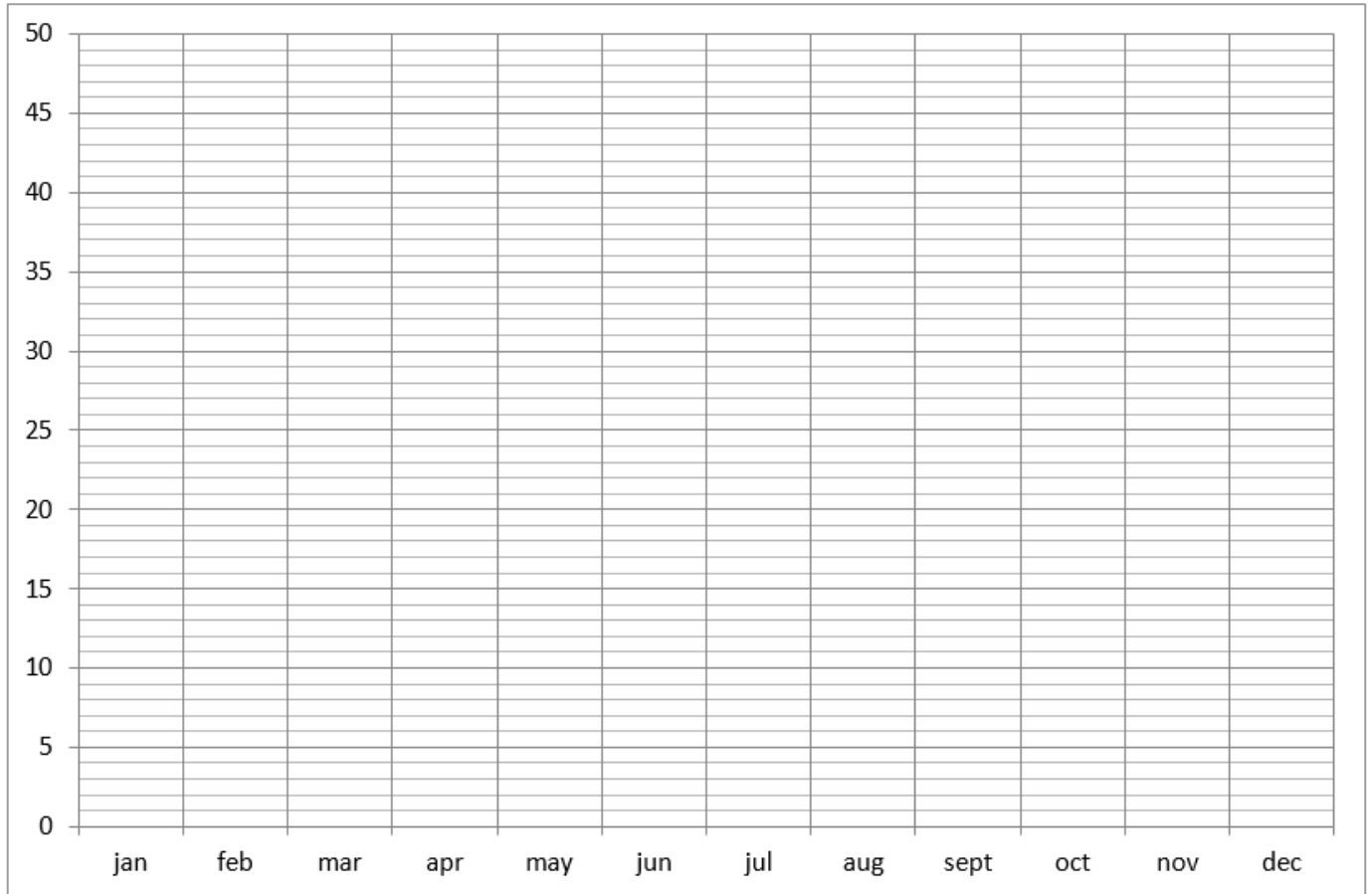

3. How much rain fell in March and July?

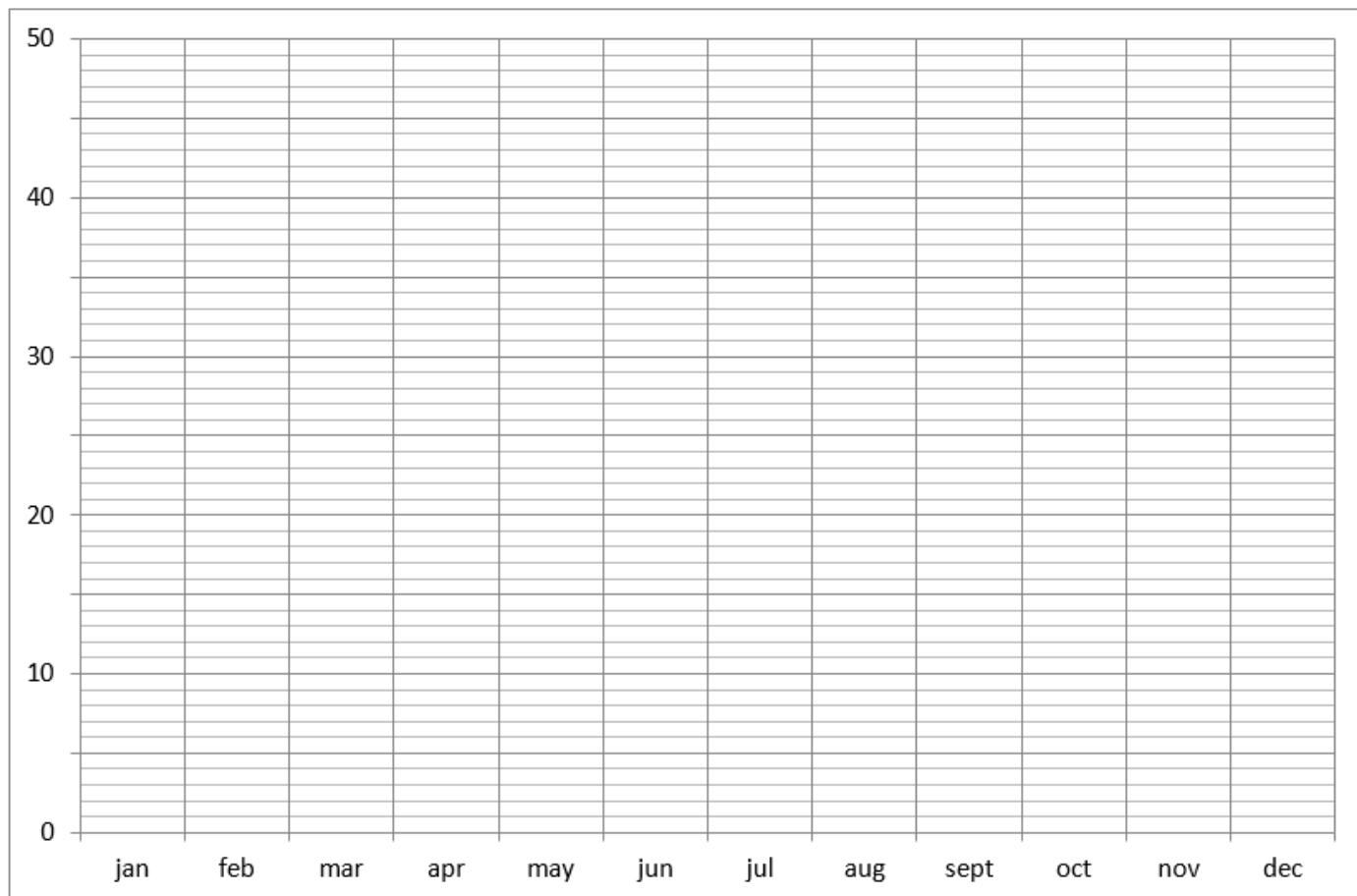
4. How much less rain does May have than June?
