<p>Week 1</p> <p>Traditional Tales</p>	<p>A listening game based on sounds that can be heard indoors. Encourage children to close their eyes when listening to the sounds as it helps them to concentrate and not be distracted by what's going on around them.</p> <p>EYFS.
